3. How interactive is the course?

This course is not a live video stream, but a pre-recorded Video Seminar ; much like a DVD you would watch at home.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- i. Yes, we require names for all participants. There is no charge for name changes.
- ii. Yes, we accept Visa, MasterCard and cheques.
- iii. No, we do not invoice so you can pay later. All registrations/orders are prepaid. You are registered **ONLY** when a complete registration and payment are received. Seats are not saved by sending a post dated cheque.
- iv. No, a post dated cheque does not receive the Early Bird Discount (nor are you registered until the actual date of the cheque).

6. How/When will I receive registration confirmation?

Unless specially indicated, your PAID invoice/confirmation will be **emailed** to the address noted on your registration form **immediately** upon receipt. **HOWEVER**, registrations received **between December 2 and December 15** may be backlogged due to quantity of registrations and the holidays.

Please do not call until at least December 28 to see if we received your fax. To avoid the rush, register early.

7. What about fees and discounts?
